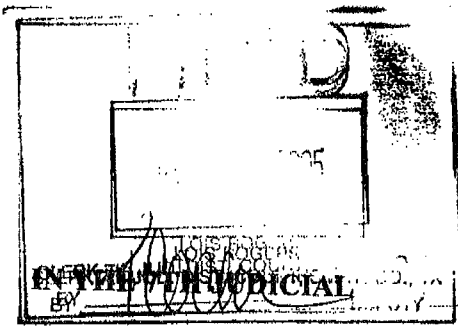

JUDGMENT OF ACQUITTAL - PLEA OF NOT GUILTY - JURY


